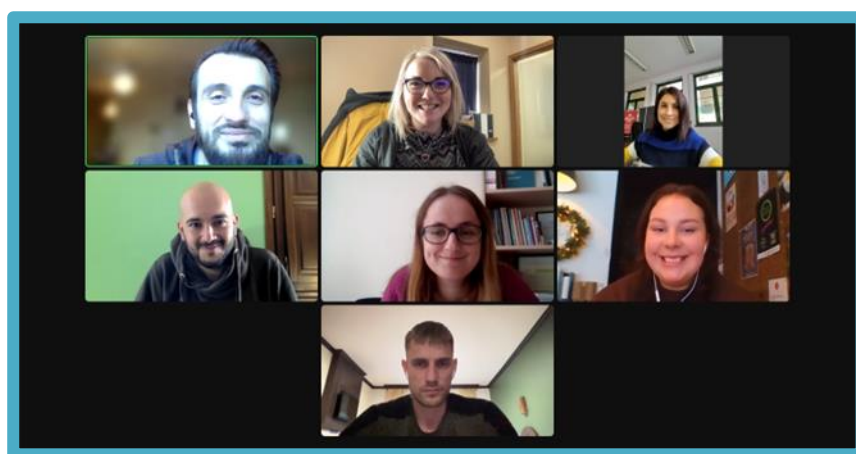
Behind C-Entry:

C-Entry First Result Published!

Over the past few months, C-Entry project partners have been working to develop the first result of our project – The Circular Economy (CE) Sectorial Assessment Methodology – which saw each partner undertaking a mapping exercise in their countries to assess how developed Circular Economic activities are in each country. The aim of this work was to produce a document that will act as the benchmark and evidence-base for all future development work in the project. Through our research activities, all partners have contributed to identifying national needs and gaps, which can now be addressed through the Interactive Infographics and other educational materials that partners will now dedicate their time and effort to develop over the coming months. To inform the development of this Assessment, questionnaires were distributed to 10 organisations active in the field of furniture, housing/building or agro-business sector in each partner country.
