Making Circular Economy Learning Interactive!

Since last summer, the C-Entry partners have been working hard to develop digital learning resources that can be brought directly to young people to increase their knowledge and skills about the circular economy – this is What we are aiming to do in this project after all!

What do these results look like? Well, we are developing them as interactive infographics! The Toolbox of Interactive Infographic Resources comprises 12 Infographic posters, each of which has digital learning activities embedded in them through QR codes, and each of which is also associated with different aspects of the circular economy. These 12 Infographic posters address the following 12 topics:

- 1. Design Out Waste
- 2. Ethical Thinking: Reuse and Remanufacturing
- 3. Regeneration of Natural Systems
- 4. Recycling
- 5. Ideas and Opportunities*
- 6. Resources*
- 7. Into Action*
- 8. Leadership
- 9. Building Resilience
- 10. Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
- 11. Creative and Innovative Thinking
- 12. Media and Information Literacy

Each topic is presented as an interactive poster, in which young people and youth workers can scan a QR code from their phone, that will bring them to an online 'resource bank'. When scanned, users will be able to access the interactive infographic resources – An Explainer Video, a Quiz, a Digital Breakout, and a Call-to-Action Activity. With this, a simple poster can be brought to life and be transformed into educational learning materials that you can use with young people in your youth work setting.

This month, we are finalising these resources in English, and looking to launch them online in July 2023! So, stay tuned for these exciting updates.
